

Addendum to Ambulance Service Agreement

Between the Fire Service agencies listed below and American Medical Response Ambulance Service, Inc.

WHEREAS, the parties wish to continue this service agreement, and acknowledge that it is mutually beneficial to do so and in the best interest of the public; and,

WHEREAS, all parties agree that by signing this amendment the City of Kirkland is party to the original agreement; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained in the original agreement for services, it is hereby agreed by the undersigned parties that the following amendments be added to the original agreement:

1. Appendix B – Section 2.2 Exemptions

ADD the following bullet:

Police Department Direct Request for Ambulance. If the Department requests the Provider to amend its standing practice to allow the Police Department to directly request an ambulance for involuntary commit transport, without Fire Department personnel being on scene, the Department agrees to grant an exemption for all calls the Provider responds to while they have a unit unavailable for this purpose.

2. Appendix B – Section 3.1 Penalties

ADD THE FOLLOWING LANGUAGE TO BEGIN SECTION 3.1:

In the event AMR meet or exceeds a ninety percent (90%) compliance rate in the contract coverage (Duvall, Bothell, Fall City, Mercer Island, Kirkland, Northshore, Woodinville, Redmond, Shoreline, Snoqualmie, Eastside Rural, Eastside Urban) area during a calendar month, the Fire Department shall waive liquidated damages for that month.

If however, the provider falls below 90% compliance in any single jurisdiction all calls for service in that jurisdiction that were not in compliance shall be assessed liquidated damages as outlined below.

3. ADD THE FOLLOWING LANGUAGE TO SERVICE AGREEMENT – II. Agreement 2.
Add second paragraph

Department acknowledges that the Provider's dynamic pre-deployment system is integral to its response time success. As such, the Department agrees to release unneeded AMR resources, via radio, as soon as is operationally possible.

4. Section 12 of Contract – Records Retention, Privacy, and Inspections

ADD TO TITLE: Electronic Patient Care Reporting,

ADD SECOND PARAGRAPH:

Provider agrees to work with each jurisdiction and King County EMS to successfully complete an electronic interface between the provider EPCR system and the system provided by King County EMS (currently ESO). The provider will work diligently and commit resources, as necessary, to successfully provide the ability for field crews to exchange information electronically while at the patient side.

5. SECTION 8.1 NOW READS AS FOLLOWS:

8.1. **Term.** Subject to the following termination provisions, the term of this Agreement shall be for a period of three (3) years commencing on October 1, 2010 and ending on September 30th, 2013, with an optional three year renewal as outlined in the RFP AND SHALL BE RENEWED AUTOMATICALLY THEREAFTER FOR SUCCESSIVE ANNUAL TERMS.
