



SHORELINE FIRE DEPARTMENT FIRE CADET PROGRAM

Selection Process

Criteria for selecting candidates for the Shoreline Fire Department Fire Cadet Program.

1. Must be at least 16 years old by the start of the program, but not older than 20 years old.
2. Must be enrolled in high school or General Educational Development (G.E.D.) program OR have graduated from high school with a diploma or G.E.D. certificate.
3. Candidates must possess/maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or equivalent in school course work.
4. The Fire Cadet Candidate shall completely fill out the Fire Cadet Program Candidate Application.
5. The Fire Cadet Program Candidate Application must be received no later than **June 1 at 4 PM.**
6. The Fire Cadet Candidate must clear the Shoreline Fire Department Fire Cadet background check.
7. The Fire Cadet Candidate must provide physician approval document at time of Cadet Program physical ability test. *(Test date to be determined)*
8. Priority will be given to residents of the City of Shoreline.
9. Priority will be given to Shoreline School District Students.
10. Candidates will be evaluated on how they answer their essay questions.
11. An interview may be given if there are more equally qualified candidates than positions available.

The below items will be used to select applicants for the Fire Cadet Program. Send in copies of the below items that apply to you.

The following information needs to be submitted to the Fire Cadet Program between May 3 and June 1 (at 4 PM). Applications received before or after the application period will be disqualified.

1. Fire Cadet Application and Questionnaire (**Mandatory**).
2. Copy of your cumulative GPA of 2.0 (recent report card) or equivalent in school course work (**Mandatory if in high school or in G.E.D. program**).
3. Copy of High School Diploma or G.E.D. certificate (**Mandatory, if you have one**).
