This Order shall be complied with by the owner, operator, occupant, or other persons responsible for the condition or violation to which the Notice and Order pertains.



All Recreational Fires – any outdoor fire
such as a backyard fire pit or campfire using
chopped firewood or charcoal

Any person found with a recreational fire who
fails to take immediate action to extinguish
or otherwise discontinue such burning when
ordered or notified to do so shall be charged
with a misdemeanor. (IFC 109)

Recreational fires are restricted until this order
is lifted or unless otherwise permitted by law
enforcement or authorized agencies.
