2. Must be in high school or General Educational Development (GED) program, or graduated from high school with a diploma or GED certificate.
3. Must possess/maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or equivalent in school course work.
4. Must pass the Cadet Program physical ability test.
5. Must pass Shoreline Fire Department Cadet background check.
6. Must meet required attendance expectations.

SELECTION PROCESS

The following information must be submitted to the Shoreline Fire Department to be considered for the Fire Cadet Program:

1. Fire Cadet Application and Questionnaire
2. Copy of cumulative GPA of 2.0 (recent report card) or equivalent in school course work
OR
Copy of High School Diploma or GED certificate.
