To qualify for the program, you must:



Be between the ages of 16 - 20 years old



Be in good physical condition (must complete the Cadet Program Physical Ability Test)



Meet required attendance expectations



Have a strong desire to pursue a career as a firefighter

Priority will be given to residents of the City of Shoreline / Shoreline School District Students



Each Cadet will learn mental and physical wellness, a sense of selfresponsibility, personal growth, leadership, teamwork and firefighting skills.

Requirements

- Minimum age of 16 to 20 years old.
- Enrollment in or graduate of a high school or GED program.
- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.0.

Time Commitment

Saturdays, 8 a.m. - 12 p.m. at Shoreline Fire Department Headquarters

Must meet 75% attendance requirement.

Cost

\$90 enrollment fee and \$10 per month in membership dues.
